Termite Bait Study from Journal of Economic Entomology

There has been good news reported for homeowners who use Termite Bait Systems using Noviflumuron. In a study reported in the Journal of Economic Entomology termites need only consume around a third of the chemical to kill the colony in many cases. This study has shown that even a short duration of the chemical within the bait systems is enough to kill termites that have been exposed. <u>Frozen Banana Bites Snack Recipe</u>

Ingredients:

- 2-3 large bananas
- 2-3 Tablespoon of coconut oil
- 1 Bar of Bakers Chocolate
- > 1/3 cup peanut butter

Directions:

Slice bananas and place on large baking mat, cover, and place in freezer until frozen.

Melt chocolate & coconut oil together. Remove banana from freezer,
place peanut butter on one side of banana slice and top it with another
slice making a sandwich. Return to freezer for 20 minutes. Remove from
freezer, dip each into chocolate and return to freezer for 2-3 hours.

Remove, place in Ziplock bag, put in freezer and enjoy.
